  - a. Have a lid created with a 45° angle to create a beveled edge.
  - b. Have a handle which is unified with the design of the vessel.
  - c. Have 3-4 feet which are proportional to the vessel and unified with the design.
  - d. Include interesting surface designs with a specific motif as your intention. Use tools and/or glaze to develop your motif. Make sure that the application of the design enhances the overall look of the vessel.
- 4. Complete the vessel by applying glaze properly.
