## Standards:

## Parameters:

1. Complete all Art Journal Assignments.
2. Choose 3 still lifes that are set up in the classroom. Create thumbnail drawings of the compositions in your art journal. (This is one of your art journal assignments)
Composition rules:

- Create the illusion of depth
- Use overlapping of objects, size, manipulate foreground, middle ground, back ground, consider placement
- Touch 4 edges of plane, go off edge
- Consider balance, unity, directional movement (eye)

3. Choose one thumbnail- return to the same still life and create a larger version of the same set up. Yes, you must return to the source for drawing.
4. Cut drawing into 4 areas. Choose which media you will use for each section.
-One must be graphite. The other 3 are your choice for media (color pencil, ink pen, oil pastel, or collage)
5. Complete each section using a different art medium carefully to create round forms, textures, and shifts in color. Do your best to keep it neat and under control!
6. On black paper create a 1 inch frame. Reassemble the four sections onto this paper neatly inside of the frame line. Glue Dots not Lots!
